What is the single greatest trait that a ballet director must have? Can a successful choreographer be a good artistic director? Join us as we discuss some of the legendary ballet directors of the 20th century. Robert was fortunate to have Dame Ninette de Valois, founder of The Royal Ballet, as his mentor. This formidable lady was generous, but demanding and insured the fruition of most British ballet's dance personalities during her time. Like George Balanchine at New York City Ballet and Lucia Chase at American Ballet Theater, their influence remains an intrinsic part of the organizations they created. We will explore the sometimes exciting and difficult path leading to a successful career in this responsible position.

Robert de Warren is an international ballet director, choreographer, and designer. He has directed a number of companies, including La Scala Theatre Ballet in Milan, and was artistic director of the Sarasota Ballet for 13 years. His memoir, *Destiny's Waltz—In Step With Giants*, covers his artistic journey.
